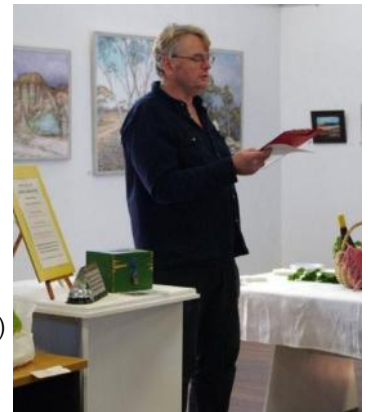

**PLEASE NOTE—KCG NO LONGER HAS A POST OFFICE BOX ADDRESS. As of MAY 1st KCG's POSTAL ADDRESS is the street address -**  
**67—69 MAIN ST, KAPUNDA, 5373.**

When housed upstairs in the Thomson Building, KCG was required to have a Post Office Box as postal delivery was limited to street-level premises. Having moved to street level we no longer need the unnecessary expense (currently \$183 p.a.) of a PO Box. **Please note the new postal address, above.**

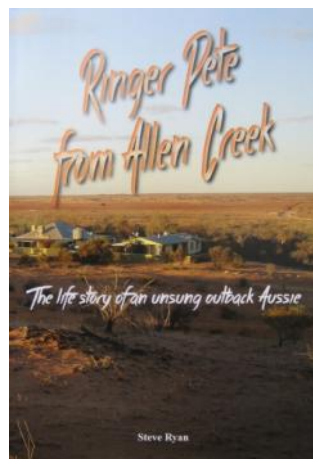
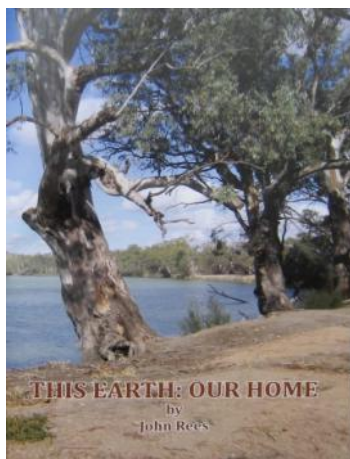
