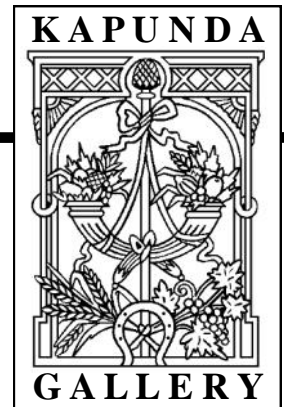

KCG hosted yet another entertaining afternoon on Sunday April 30th, hosting two book launches each with links to KCG Friends.

John Rees poetry book “This Earth:Our Home” was introduced by KCG Chairperson, Maxine Donald.

It is the fourth book in the “Earth” poetry series by John. John's appreciation of nature is simply and beautifully expressed in a way with which we can all connect.

**FROM THE CHAIRPERSON — MAXINE DONALD**

The pace has been hectic! Several events and projects have 'come together in the past month, much to the joy of many!

The **book launches** (on page one) were a joyous occasion and, as seems to be the stamp of KCG events the friendship, chat, food and drinks flowed easily.

That day was also the first occasion that our 'catering crew' (coordinated by Helen Ryan) used **the new Staffroom facility!** After two years without running water, cupboard and bench space we were in absolute heaven!

Once again our **thanks** goes to **Nick Champion** for his recommendation of our application for the Federal Govt. \$for\$ Grant that enabled the projects to get off the ground; **BJ Moore** for submitting the lengthy Grant application and supervising the project; the 'build' manager **Tristan Kerr (Kerrstructions)** and his tradespeople; **Bob Harrison** and the Work for the Dole team in the initial stages; Plumber **Gary Hawke** and Electrician **John Clapshoe**. Ofcourse, **without fundraising and excellent fund management from within KCG we would not have had the funds to match the Grant in the first place, so WELL DONE "Team KCG"!**

The Project came in at about \$100 over the total budget of \$24,500 (of which Grant funding provided \$12,200.00). KCG has now authorized approximately \$600 over and above the \$25,000 to install a security door, some additional minor fittings (such as steps for little people to reach overhead cupboards) and a laundry sink and hotwater service in the back lobby area.

Gallery Attendants are ecstatic and thoroughly deserve their new-found 'luxury'!

We are still finding 'the right place' for things and searching behind closed doors for articles already placed, but there are no complaints about that. The security door allows ventilation and easy outdoor access, hitherto unavailable.

The much anticipated "Murals Launch" took place on May 7th. Sincere thanks to the KCG organizing sub-committee comprising Helen Ryan, Barb Zwarts, Caro Tolley, John Low and BJ Moore. The event went like clock-work with an estimated 120 people present to witness the launches firstly at the POST OFFICE, then the MFS, on to the NORTH KAPUNDA HOTEL wall in Crase St. and ending up at KCG for celebratory food and drinks!

Earlier in April I had an opportunity to visit the BEGA VALLEY REGIONAL ART GALLERY in southern NSW where a selection of works from the 2016 ARCHIBALD PRIZE were on display. Having never seen the Archibald other than on my computer screen, I hadn't anticipated so much diversity in media, style, technique and size! The works were incredible, with several stand-outs for me. Whilst there I pondered BVRG in comparison to KCG ..... I decided KCG has an ambience that was distinctly lacking there— but maybe I am biased! If only even a small part of the Archibald could come to KCG "one day"!

I am looking forward to the Demonstration by Roe Gartelman on Sun. May 28th (See Page 3) and then the next Exhibition Opening at the Gallery on June 4th at 2pm. (See column, Page 1.) **Please come and enjoy time together (and have a peek at the Staffroom)!** Continued next Page >>>>>>>>>>
