FROM THE EDITOR / CHAIRPERSON

Kapunda Community Gallery Inc.

K.C.G. has the Keys to the Hambour Building in Main Street, Kapunda!

Hopefully all KCG Friends will be now be aware that the RELOCATION Proposal was passed at the Light Regional Council meeting in March. **The Lease for the Hambour Building has subsequently been signed**—LRC is leasing the building and KCG will be the tenant and manager. A further Agreement to this effect will be signed between LRC and KCG in the near future.

Whilst this is the outcome we have worked so hard to achieve and it is **very exciting**, it is **also a little daunting** as there is so much to do! However, I keep reminding myself and others, that when KCG began in the Thomson building it too required much work and that space as I know it was certainly not achieved instantly! (Just ask our Life Members!)

Fortunately KCG has a very **enthusiastic Committee**, with a number of the members agreeing to oversight **sub-committees** in the various areas that need immediate attention. **Priority is the Painting, Hanging system, Lighting and Mobile Screens.**

Thank you to those who have responded eagerly to assisting with the cost of the new Hanging system (as I canvassed in the previous Newsletter.) This will assist us to apply for FUNDING, much of which is Dollar for Dollar. The Committee is hoping that KCG Friends will contribute either financially (such as by 'donating' a piece of track, or hanging mechanism, as suggested in the previous Newsletter) or physically (assisting with the actual 'renovation' tasks that we face). **DONATIONS** can be made at the Gallery, by mail to the Gallery or by Direct Deposit (see Website).

Work will begin as soon as possible, hopefully in the week after Easter so that we can 'open' as soon as possible.

One of the people who gave support and expertise during our relocation application was **Maz McGann** (Chair of the Regional Galleries Association and Manager of Arts & Culture at the Barossa Council). Maz has recently been **appointed as C.E.O. of 'Creative Australia'** a newly created arts organization, based in Sydney. **KCG wishes Maz well in her new position and we thank her for the time and enthusiasm she gave to both the RGASA and to KCG's relocation proposal.**

Prior to the upcoming 'CELEBRATING KAPUNDA' Exhibition I am asking ALL CONTRIBUTORS to KCG exhibitions to **READ AND ADHERE** to the 'Hanging Devices and Arrangements' clearly set out on Page 3. This is extremely important as we do not wish to reject any works when they are delivered. Presentation of artwork is important and KCG's requisites are consistent with those of other galleries.

In addition to those who can help with the relocation activities I look forward to seeing as many of you as possible at the **Sitter's Afternoon Tea and/or the Opening of 'Celebrating Kapunda'**. We do indeed have much to celebrate in this the 25th Anniversary year of KCG!

HANGING DEVICES AND ARRANGEMENTS

Works should be **suitably framed**. If on **unframed canvas the edges should be finished neatly**.

Glass should be clean. Check for marks on the inside of the glass.

All hanging works must be fitted with **large D rings**. **Minimum size is as illustrated below left**. This enables the hanging hook to fit easily into the D ring.

Any artwork that does not have the right D rings **will not be hung**.

(This has been an ongoing problem for the hanging team as incorrect D rings makes correct hanging very difficult.)

The D rings should be **placed from a quarter to one-third down** from the top of the frame with a **taut (not tight) wire** between—centre illustration below

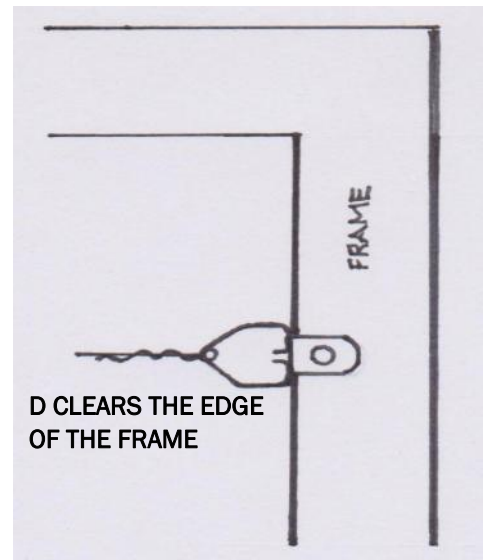
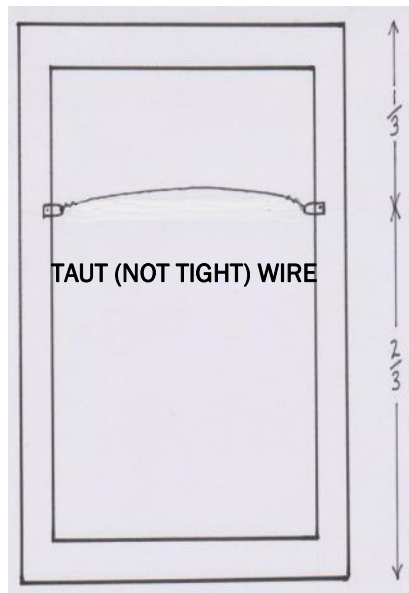
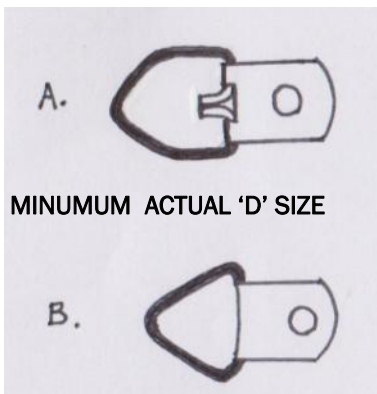
We do not hang by wire. Please do not use cord.

D rings must be placed so that they **clear the inside edge of the frame** (so that the hanging hook has easy access) **as illustrated below right**.

PLEASE SHARE THIS INFORMATION WITH YOUR PICTURE FRAMER.

D rings are for sale in Kapunda Community Gallery.

All works must have a **LABEL** firmly attached to bottom rear corner of work showing **TITLE, ARTIST's NAME, MEDIUM & PRICE**. 3D items should have the label underneath.



DELIVERY AND COLLECTION AT K.C.G.

Artworks are always **DELIVERED** on a given **TUESDAY**, to the Gallery **between 10am and 4pm**. Late works will not be hung.

COLLECTION is always on a given **MONDAY** between 10am and 4pm.

Please contact the Exhibition Coordinator if genuine difficulties are encountered,

BY THE FRIDAY PRIOR TO THE DELIVERY / COLLECTION DATE.

PLEASE REMEMBER THAT KCG is a TOTALLY VOLUNTARY GALLERY so adherence to all policies is very much appreciated by all our unpaid workers!

EXHIBITING IN THE NORTH KAPUNDA HOTEL DINING ROOM

Hanging devices are the same as for KCG. Changeover of paintings is always the **2nd TUESDAY** of March, June, Sept, Dec. **AT 9 am sharp**. All works **MUST** be collected at that time as there is **no storage facility at the Hotel**.

ALL EXHIBITING ARTISTS ARE REQUIRED TO ASSIST WITH HANGING AT LEAST ONCE PER YEAR—March being the beginning of the hanging year.
