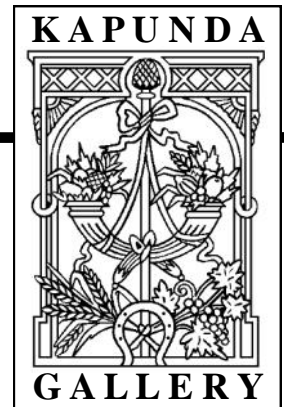

FROM THE CHAIRPERSON—Maxine Donald. Kapunda Community Gallery Inc.

In July I attended a Workshop convened jointly by the Kapunda Business Alliance and Light Regional Council, to discuss the future 'view' of Kapunda's Main Street given the removal of the vines. The invitation was extended to Main Street business/building owners/tenants. For me personally it was very disappointing to see so few attendees, given the importance of Main Street to our community, to visitors and to business.

Whilst nothing was resolved at the meeting, ideas were presented and information gained by all present.

South Australian Living Artists (SALA) Festival has taken over August all over our state, including our Gallery! It was wonderful to welcome about sixty-five people to the **Opening of "Postcode 5373" by Mr. Paul McCarthy.** Paul is known to many locally, having lived and been involved in our community for some 40 years. It was lovely to have Paul and his wife Kerry as our guests for the afternoon. As several visitors remarked, KCG Openings are always a joyous social occasion!

We had the pleasure once again of welcoming the Member for Stuart, Dan van Holst–Pellekaan and his wife Rebecca. Both are keen supporters of the Arts and visit KCG whenever their busy schedule permits. LRC Mayor Bill O'Brien also attended, with wife Marilyn in costume, assisting with the "Living History" exhibit—see photos Page 1.

Four representatives from KCG attended the Regional Galleries Assoc. of SA (RGASA) Forum at Seppeltsfield on August 5th for an interesting day of "arts conversation and information". We came away with some ideas and inspiration, which was the objective of the forum. Hopefully there will be time and opportunity to implement some of these! Some of the presenters were from interstate regional facilities (NSW) and it was very interesting to hear about their experiences. **Thanks to RGASA for organizing the event.**

Work on the Staffroom development has begun! With the assistance of the 'work for the dole' local scheme, coordinated through Andrew Philpott (Environment Manager with LRC) and under the direction of Bob Harrison, the small room has been literally gutted ready for the necessary renovations and refitting. We are very grateful to the 'team' for the work they are doing - but not so much for the dust with which we are having to contend My old standby line, "you have to have a caterpillar before there emerges a butterfly" is brought starkly to mind—it WILL all be worth it!

Next KCG exhibition is by Barossa artist Debbie Seater. Another very different exhibition experience awaits and I sincerely hope as many as possible will support Debbie at the official **Opening by Pam Makin on Sun. September 11th.**

The Committee tries to keep all Friends up to date with any significant changes that happen with regard to Gallery procedure. Sometimes things get overlooked in our busy volunteer lives. If you are interested in a particular aspect of the Gallery we ask that you check from time to time to see what is current.
