SALA (South Australian Living Artists) month is an exciting and interesting time! **BURRA** Regional Gallery's **SALA** exhibition "**The Art Teachers**" focusses on art teachers who maintain their own art practice, in addition to their teaching. Just prior to the official exhibition opening visitors were invited to take part in a forum "to draw attention to the core benefits art can play in the lives of young people". The two Panel Members were **Dan van Holst-Pellekaan (Member for Stuart)** and **Kylie Neagle (Education Officer at AGSA and former Art Teacher at Trinity College Gawler)**.

The discussion was extremely interesting, with a lot of apparent frustration that **art, as a subject in schools and it's perceived relevance in life generally, is greatly devalued**. However, by the end of the Forum attendees were buoyed by the ideas, enthusiasm and commitment to the challenges ahead.

Another exhibition, totally different in concept and reason was that of the **Open Studio of Trevor Hancox** (KCG Friend from Mt. Barker), with substantial proceeds going to **Cranio-Facial Australia**. Several KCG Friends visited, lending their support to a fellow artist and the cause!

Thank you to **KCG's new VOLUNTEER 'Shop Dresser', ALICE TILLEY**. Alice is a busy mum of two littlies with a great deal of artistic talent and this task is right up her alley! Thank you so much for answering the call Alice!

The 2018 EXHIBITION CALENDAR is COMPLETE! It is varied and we think will appeal to visitors, locals and artists alike. **The 2018 SALA exhibition will be OPEN TO ALL ARTISTS**, but with a theme, special entry conditions and an increased entry fee (to cover costs of registering as an official SALA event).
