**FROM THE CHAIRPERSON — MAXINE DONALD**

Since the last Newsletter KCG has seen the hanging, opening and dismantling of the annual Kapunda Schools' Exhibition. Stuart Hoerisch (KHS) and Trudi Conway (KPS) once again convened works from each school and presented them for the benefit of students, their families and the public at K.C.G.

A former student of both schools, DANNY MENZEL officially opened the exhibition to the delight of all present. Danny has successfully developed his love and talent for art into a successful Graphic Art business in Kapunda, DM Graphics.

There continues to be some very talented young artists in our community and it is KCG's pleasure to acknowledge and appreciate local youth art with the Schools Exhibition each November.

Painting of the POST OFFICE MURAL is taking place in the Gallery basement (a nice cool spot in Summer) with about 16 volunteers painting under the direction of Supervising Artist Danny Menzel. Working 2 days per week, 2 shifts per day the basic background painting will be completed before Christmas. When painting resumes again around mid-January detail will be increasingly added. Whilst a completion date has not been set, Danny foresees a couple of months more work after work is restarted.

Meanwhile the volunteers are enjoying the social and artistic experience!

A shadecloth awning has been erected at the front of the Gallery at last, giving protection to the windows from the early morning summer sun's rays. This is a temporary measure until a much more aesthetic solution can be found to the problem. The beautiful old Gallery building deserves to look much better than its current front facade permits.

Progress with the staffroom has once again been delayed, for reasons beyond 'our' control. Hopefully by the next newsletter in February I can report some REAL progress!

On the 8th of December the first meeting of the 2017 Kapunda Kidman Rotary Art Show was held to get next October's Art Show preparations underway. I will be calling on all Friends to be involved in booking in, hanging, manning and booking out the exhibits October 18th — 26th inclusive in 2017. The event is the major bi-annual fundraiser for KCG and a lot of help is required over the 9 day period.

The opening of the annual Summer Exhibition was very successful with about 60 people in attendance. Congratulations to all artists involved. Roger Murcott kindly judged the works and was very complimentary regarding the overall standard exhibits. Thanks go to Deputy Mayor Deane Rohrlach for opening the exhibition. As always many contributed to the event, in a wide range of ways and my thanks go to all.
