By noon the electricians were in and the dismantling had begun! Between Tuesday and Friday the new suspended ceiling will be installed. The lighting will be re-installed next week, to be followed by some painting and then cleaning, renovation and re-oiling of the beautiful old jarrah floor.

FROM THE CHAIRPERSON

Kapunda Community Gallery Inc.

As outlined on Page 1. we are on track for an **opening of the annual “Summer Exhibition” on SUNDAY DECEMBER 3rd at 2pm.** At the Opening Awards will be made to Artists and a cheque received from the Kapunda Rotary Club for KCG’s vital part in organizing the recent successful Kidman Art Show. **WE WOULD LOVE TO SEE YOU ALL THERE FOR THE GRAND RE-OPENING.** It will be the ideal opportunity to see the new ceiling and refurbished floor for yourselves!

Speaking of these changes I would like to thank **Mark (Hambour) and Jenny** for their response to our devastation. Mark was quickly on to the insurance company. Assessors and quotations were obtained and repairs underway as soon as possible, given the extent of the damage. Mark has been in constant contact, advising of progress in each step and time-frames involved. I thank him for recognising the importance of this communication. It is appreciated.

Unfortunately the whole situation was and is, **a severe setback for KCG as we have lost substantial income from window hire, shop sales, donations from visitors through the door and exhibition commissions for THE two major retail trading months in the year.** Unfortunately for KCG (but good for all others) we were the only venue in the town that suffered this loss due to the storm. (And thank goodness we were spared the fire!)

On November 24th **KCG reported to Light Regional Council on its first full year of operation since the relocation.** When all that has been (is being) achieved was succinctly verbalized in 5 minutes, WE have achieved an amazing amount in a short space of time. Hopefully our report served to demonstrate our ongoing ‘value’ to the town and region—in almost any area of social, health and economic terms one can think of.

In the previous Newsletter I reported that KCG with the expertise of Web Master Eric Clarke had applied for **two refurbished (ex-govt) computers to expand our activities in the Gallery space.** The Grant has been approved, the relevant documents signed and I will keep the membership advised as the proposed use of the computers is up and running! Sincere thanks to Eric for his extra input into this project.

Meanwhile KCG’s **“Fund My Idea” proposal for Kapunda to become a Mural Town is open for ONLINE VOTING until Nov. 16th.** (See page 1 for information on how to vote.) This would be an ‘all of community project providing social, health and economic benefits for our town and region. **PLEASE GET BEHIND THIS INITIATIVE by VOTING FOR IT.**

Just around the next corner is the AGM—7pm Mon. Feb. 22nd 2016 in the Gallery. **Who amongst you would like to join the Committee? It is a serious question! We need AT LEAST ONE NEW MEMBER,** in addition to the three who have come forward to volunteer for off-committee tasks :) (and we could still use more in that department also).

HANGING DEVICES AND ARRANGEMENTS

Works should be suitably framed. If on unframed canvas the edges should be finished neatly.

Glass should be clean. Check for marks on the inside of the glass.

All hanging works must be fitted with large D rings. Minimum size is as illustrated below left. This enables the hanging hook to fit easily into the D ring.

Any artwork that does not have the CORRECT ‘D’ rings will not be hung.

(This has been an ongoing problem for the hanging team as incorrect D rings makes correct hanging very difficult.)

The D rings should be placed from a quarter to one-third down from the top of the frame with a taut (not tight) wire between—centre illustration below

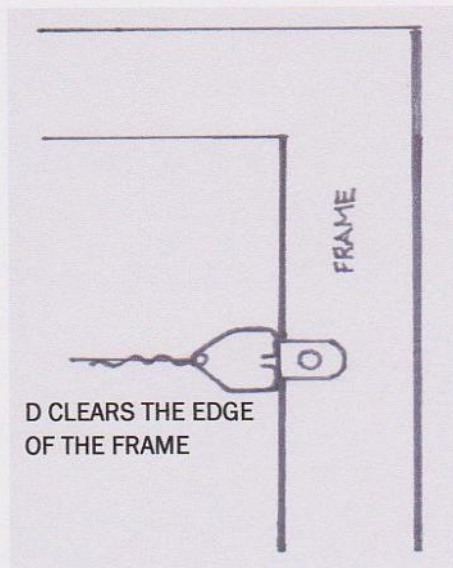
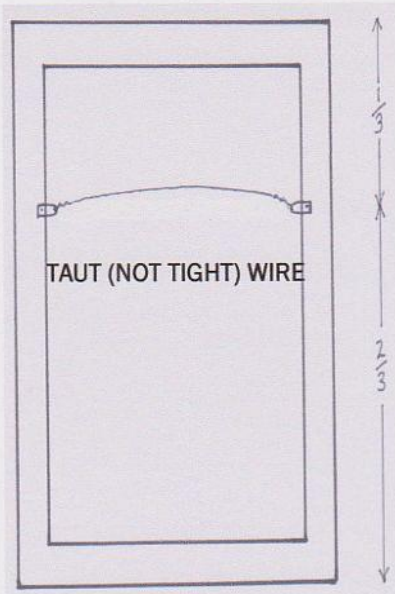
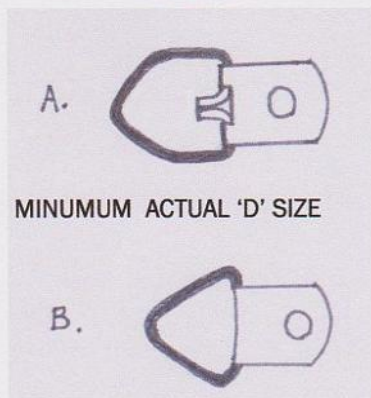
We do not hang by wire. Please do not use cord.

D rings must be placed so that they clear the inside edge of the frame (so that the hanging hook has easy access) as illustrated below right.

PLEASE SHARE THIS INFORMATION WITH YOUR PICTURE FRAMER.

D rings are for sale in Kapunda Community Gallery.

All works must have a **LABEL** firmly attached to bottom rear corner of work showing **TITLE, ARTIST'S NAME, MEDIUM & PRICE**. 3D items should have the label underneath.



DELIVERY AND COLLECTION

DELIVERY is ALWAYS on a GIVEN TUESDAY. The DATE for each Exhibition is listed on the KCG Exhibition Calendar and OPEN Exhibition delivery dates are given in Newsletter (Hanging Around) when the exhibition is advertised. **DELIVERY HOURS are strictly between 10am and 4pm on the advertised TUESDAY.**

COLLECTION is ALWAYS on a GIVEN MONDAY and is also listed on the Exhibition Calendar. **COLLECTION is strictly between the hours of 10am and 4pm on the given MONDAY.**

EXHIBITORS ARE REQUESTED TO ADHERE TO THESE ARRANGEMENTS AS EVERYONE AT KCG IS A VOLUNTEER. If there are genuine difficulties with Delivery or Collection please contact the Exhibition Coordinator, Jenny Bastians to make alternative arrangements (see Committee contact details, P 2.)
