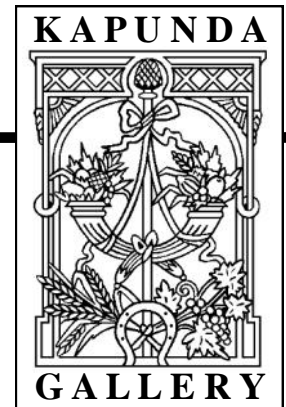

## A NEW YEAR—A NEW EXHIBITION

The first exhibitions for 2018 opened on Sunday February 11th. Two Artists **LYNN MACK** and **JOE DENNIS** are independently sharing the gallery space with their respective exhibitions, “Beauty in the Broken” and “Out and About”.

Lynn’s exhibition was opened by Archaeologist **Susan Arthure** and Joe’s exhibition by family friend **Robert Sampson**.

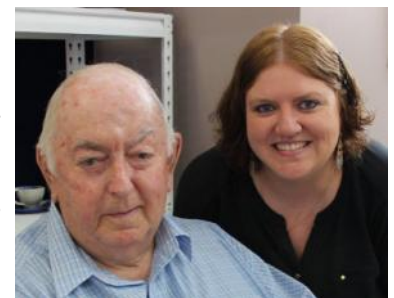
