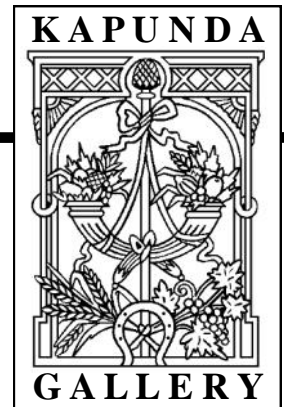

FROM THE CHAIRPERSON—Maxine Donald. Kapunda Community Gallery Inc.

There has been little rest for the Committee and volunteers since the New Year, with the re-opening of the Gallery on January 2nd. Since then it has been hectic, with two Exhibition Openings, reorganizing the Gallery Shop and suppliers, memberships, planning Workshops, rosters, reviewing the Constitution and planning the AGM—there is always something that needs attention!

Meanwhile **we wait for news regarding our application for a Grant through the Stronger Communities scheme** to secure dollar-for-dollar funding for the much needed **Gallery Staffroom/Tearoom**. I keep telling myself that every day waited is another day closer to hearing ‘good news’ At least we haven’t been told we have not been successful. Ever the optimist!

Some Friends may be aware through publicity that **KCG has embarked on another very exciting project for the Kapunda community**. We were unsuccessful with our “Fund My Idea” submission **to make Kapunda a Mural Town** (inspired by Sheffield in Tasmania) but prompted by the Kapunda Business Alliance, KCG has continued with substantial KBA assistance, to pursue the concept. The project has logically fallen under the KCG umbrella of activities; an enthusiastic **KCG sub-committee** has been formed and initial investigations and planning is underway. Light Regional Council has given ‘in-principle’ support to the project and the committee will be working closely with Council to ensure that the project meets the necessary heritage and planning requirements. The sub-committee had its first meeting last week - **Chairperson Maxine Donald, Secretary/Treasurer Anne Gonaus, Minute-taker Deane Rohrlach and members Bill Adams, Mal Craig, Danny Menzel and Tristan Kerr—a multi-faceted team that is certainly not lacking in expertise or enthusiasm!** I look forward to reporting each month on the Mural Project progress and am happy to talk to Community and Service groups who are interested in knowing more and possibly contributing financially or physically to the project. **We look forward to interest and involvement by many individuals, businesses and groups .**

There are two **Art Workshops** already **open for bookings** (see page 3). Other 2016 Workshops and Demonstrations are in the planning stages.

KCG will be participating in the Farm Fair in April to promote awareness of the creative and volunteering opportunities provided by KCG and the social and health advantages of being part of the vibrant organization that we are.

The mere mention of “A.G.M.” strikes terror in the heart of many, conjuring up visions of conscription on the night, unwanted responsibility, impingement on valuable free time (sound familiar?) **Well the KCG AGM will NOT be like that!** However, we do need your INPUT AT THE MEETING to ensure that KCG continues to grow and provide the creative environment that our Friends and community enjoy. **Business at this AGM (details P.4) includes a new DRAFT CONSTITUTION.** (The original has served KCG well for many, many years but has become quite cumbersome to work within in these evolving times.) You will receive a copy WITH THIS NEWSLETTER and I ask that you peruse, consider and make comment on the Draft at the AGM. A Motion will be presented to accept the Draft, with or without amendment. There will also be the **Election of Committee**. There are eleven candidates prepared to stand.

So **PLEASE come along** and hear first-hand what is happening—we have seating for roughly 30 but if in doubt, bring a chair!

It has been a great start to 2016. Let’s keep the momentum happening!
