FROM THE CHAIRPERSON

The South Australian Living Artist (SALA) festival is with us again, with an absolute feast of diverse artworks on display all over South Australia. A number of KCG Artists have works entered in exhibitions (see the SALA Guide online, or there are some hard copies in the Kapunda Gallery). Few artists have forwarded their details to 'Hanging Around' so unfortunately we are unable to print a comprehensive listing.

I am very much looking forward to KCG's SALA contribution—two solo exhibitions with works from CATHY JULIEN and VAL SURCH. Both artists have a 'connection' to Kapunda; both are at very different 'places' in their artistic careers and their works are very different. Promising to be a highlight in this year's calendar, both exhibitions will be opened simultaneously by JENNY BASTIANS, (Kapunda resident, KCG Member and former KCG Exhibition Coordinator).

Following on from the very productive Workshop held in June, Kirstie Jamieson (courtesy Regional Galleries Association of SA) will facilitate another session for the committee around **Strategic Planning**. With so much to do physically to get the Gallery where we need it to be and with one year of the initial five-year period already 'gone' (in which we have achieved an incredible amount) a workable strategic plan for the future is essential. I look forward to reporting the outcome in the next newsletter.

August has been a 'challenging' month for Wendy and Jill doing the Gallery roster. Not only is it the time of year when many people seek to escape our winter but it is also the time when many succumb to the ailments associated with the season! Put both those scenarios with an aging gallery attendant list and resources are stretched beyond the limit. If we are unable to recruit more volunteers we may need to consider reducing the opening hours. In my opinion this would be a retrograde step, given that visitor numbers and sales have doubled—KCG is one of the few 'attractions' in the town/region that is currently open 7 days per week (a fact often commented upon by visitors).

A reminder that this is **KCG's MAJOR FUNDRAISER** and will go a long way towards the connection of water and planned renovations in the Gallery.
