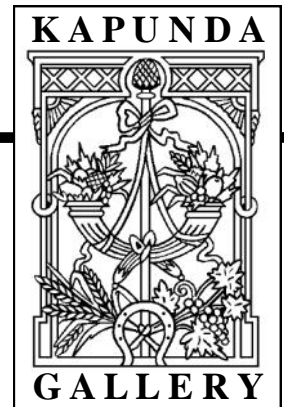

“OBSERVING MARGARET”

Experienced artist MARGARET TUCKEY demonstrated her style and skill using Acrylic for KCG recently.

The Demonstration was all that attendees could ask for—frank answers to questions; lots of information; discussion about ‘all things acrylic’ and the opportunity to watch paint being applied.

Margaret worked on two paintings—the first a landscape (top right) from a photographic reference, using a brush. The second was a still-life set up, using palette knife (bottom right) over a previously prepared textured canvas surface.

Everyone went away with at least several hints on improving their personal use of acrylic media.

I recently spent two weeks on a trip north to our beautiful 'red centre' and was not disappointed by its natural beauty.
