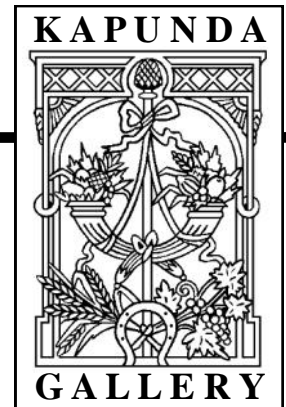

A small gathering attended the **A.G.M.** Bob McCance officiated with the Election of the 2015 Management Committee, after the Reports by 2014 Office Bearers.

Following a very hectic and inspiring year for KCG **three new Committee Members** stepped forward to join nine previous Members who wished to restand. No ballot was required, all twelve being elected unanimously.

The 2015 Committee comprises Office Bearers Maxine Donald (Chairperson) **Christine White** (Secretary) **Irene Woodcock** (Treasurer) **Jill Innes** (Friends Coordinator) and **Bill McGowan** (Exhibition Coordinator) **General Members** are **Jill Bonner** (Giftshop Coordinator) **Leonie Boyd** (Newsletter) **Leeza Jeffree** (assisting the Treasurer) **B.J. Moore** (assisting the Exhibition Coordinator) **Anne Patterson** (Flyers and Invitations) **Helen Ryan** (Opening catering) and **Barb Zwarts** (Window Hire).

Anne Gonaus is continuing with her **ex-officio** role as KCG's Regional Galleries Representative, Workshop organizer and Exhibition Publicity person whilst **Eric Clarke** thankfully continues as our Webmaster.

The first meeting of the new Committee got off to a good start on Friday 13th March with the clarification of tasks ahead and general discussion about a wide range of 'things still to be done'!

The October **KAPUNDA KIDMAN ROTARY ART SHOW** will be a major focus this year as this will once again be a major fundraiser, via the generous donation KCG receives from Rotary for our substantial part in the organization of the event. This year's donation will be most welcome as the Committee is beginning to get advice and quotes on upgrading the Gallery to include running water, a sink and hand basin to make life much easier for our volunteers and at Exhibition Openings.

Work has begun on a **tri-fold advertising brochure** for KCG to assist in further promoting the Gallery. We anticipate the brochure will be available some time in May and are extremely pleased that we can access the necessary expertise within our town—keeping it “local”!

There will be two exhibitions opening on Easter Sunday and we are hoping for a good crowd to join with the many local Artists involved in each of the groups, the Truro Art Group and the Monday Art Group.

The North Kapunda Hotel Dining Room Display was changed on 10 March and already one painting has sold—**Congratulations to Trevor Hancox**. With 5 works sold from the previous display the venue is proving a good point-of-sale for KCG Artists.

HANGING DEVICES AND ARRANGEMENTS

Works should be **suitably framed**. If on **unframed canvas** the edges should be finished neatly.

Glass should be **clean**. Check for marks on the **inside of the glass**.

All hanging works must be fitted with **large D rings**. **Minimum size is as illustrated below left**. This enables the hanging hook to fit easily into the D ring.

Any artwork that does not have the CORRECT ‘D’ rings will not be hung.

(This has been an ongoing problem for the hanging team as incorrect D rings makes correct hanging very difficult.)

The D rings should be **placed from a quarter to one-third down** from the top of the frame with a **taut (not tight) wire** between—**centre illustration below**

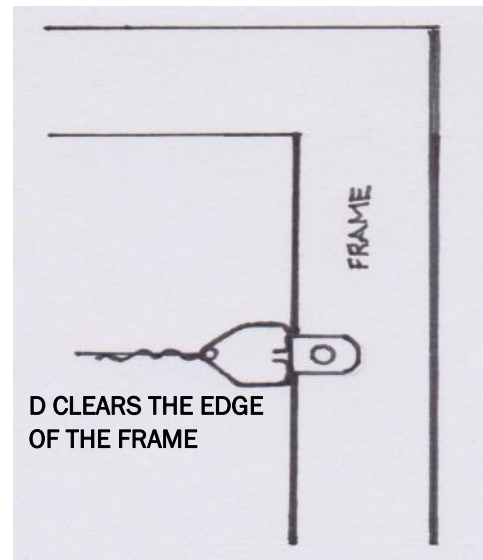
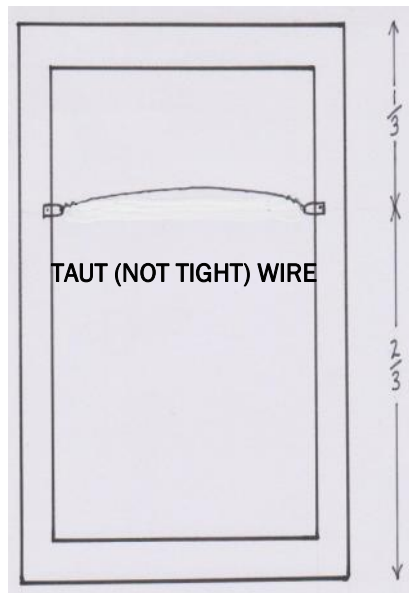
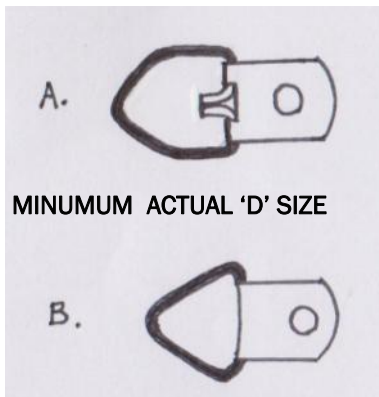
We do not hang by wire. **Please do not use cord**.

D rings must be placed so that they **clear the inside edge of the frame** (so that the hanging hook has easy access) **as illustrated below right**.

PLEASE SHARE THIS INFORMATION WITH YOUR PICTURE FRAMER.

D rings are for sale in Kapunda Community Gallery.

All works must have a **LABEL** firmly attached to **bottom rear corner of work** showing **TITLE, ARTIST’s NAME, MEDIUM & PRICE**. 3D items should have the label underneath.



DELIVERY AND COLLECTION

DELIVERY is ALWAYS on a GIVEN TUESDAY. The DATE for each Exhibition is listed on the KCG Exhibition Calendar and OPEN Exhibition delivery dates are given in Newsletter (Hanging Around) when the exhibition is advertised. **DELIVERY HOURS are strictly between 10am and 4pm on the advertised TUESDAY.**

COLLECTION is ALWAYS on a GIVEN MONDAY and is also listed on the Exhibition Calendar. **COLLECTION is strictly between the hours of 10am and 4pm on the given MONDAY.**

EXHIBITORS ARE REQUESTED TO ADHERE TO THESE ARRANGEMENTS AS EVERYONE AT KCG IS A VOLUNTEER. If there are genuine difficulties with Delivery or Collection please contact the Exhibition Coordinator, Jenny Bastians to make alternative arrangements (see Committee contact details, P 2.)
