FROM THE CHAIRPERSON—Maxine Donald. Kapunda Community Gallery Inc.

Once again it was a **small gathering at the February AGM**. Perhaps people were put off by the need to discuss and adopt the rewritten constitution. It did take a while but the changes were made and carried. However a SPECIAL GENERAL MEETING needs to be held (see page 4 for details) to insert a section which in our rewrite, according to the Act contained insufficient detail. The meeting is needed to rectify this and I ask as many as possible to attend the <u>short</u> SGM to ensure that the new constitution meets all the legal requirements and thus passes the scrutiny of Consumer and Business Services.

Thank you to Bob McCance for conducting the election of the 2016 Committee, as listed in the left-hand column. JOHN LOW has replaced Jill Innes as FRIENDS COORDINATOR and will now be the CONTACT PERSON for Friends matters. Thank you sincerely to Jill for her work in the position over the past 8 years—a job well done! Leonie Boyd also stepped down from the Committee but will continue to support us from the sidelines. Thank you Leonie. LEEZA JEFFREE has assumed the role of TREASURER, with former treasurer Irene Woodcock remaining on the committee and supporting Leeza.

As many Friends are aware, KCG HAS RECEIVED THE "STRONGER COMMUNITIES GRANT" which we applied for in 2015 to create the much-needed Staffroom. Running water will finally be connected into the building! KCG will match the \$12,100 Federal funds for the project. Thanks must go to Norma McCarthy for the initial approach to the Member's office re eligibility; KCG Committee for sourcing information and in particular BJ Moore for writing and submitting the application. KCG is extremely grateful to Nick Champion (Member for Wakefield) for his recommendation of our application. Nick will visit the Gallery on Friday April 8th at 3pm (whilst in Kapunda for the Farm Fair) and we would like any and all Friends to come along to show their appreciation for the Grant—and to have a publicity photo to mark the occasion.

May the work begin as soon as Development Approval is obtained ...

The "Kapunda, Mural Town" project is gaining momentum. A grant application is in process; donations are being sought and on-site help is being enlisted to assist with painting and construction of the first mural, which we hope will be 'unveiled' before the end of the year (at the latest)!

KCG is keen for artists and anyone interested in helping to paint the murals (guided and oversighted by an experienced artist) to register their interest, by giving contact details via email— kcg@kapundagallery.com or leaving same at the Gallery in the Diary. The project will be ongoing and there will be opportunities at some stage for as many as may wish to be involved. Community involvement is paramount!

I was one of 10 attendees at the **Damien Shen Drawing Workshop** on March 12th. It was absolutely brilliant—very informative, hands on and extremely well tutored by Damien. <u>Thanks to Anne Gonaus</u> for arranging this excellent afternoon of instruction and enlightenment!
