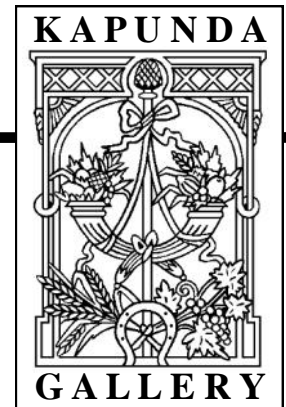

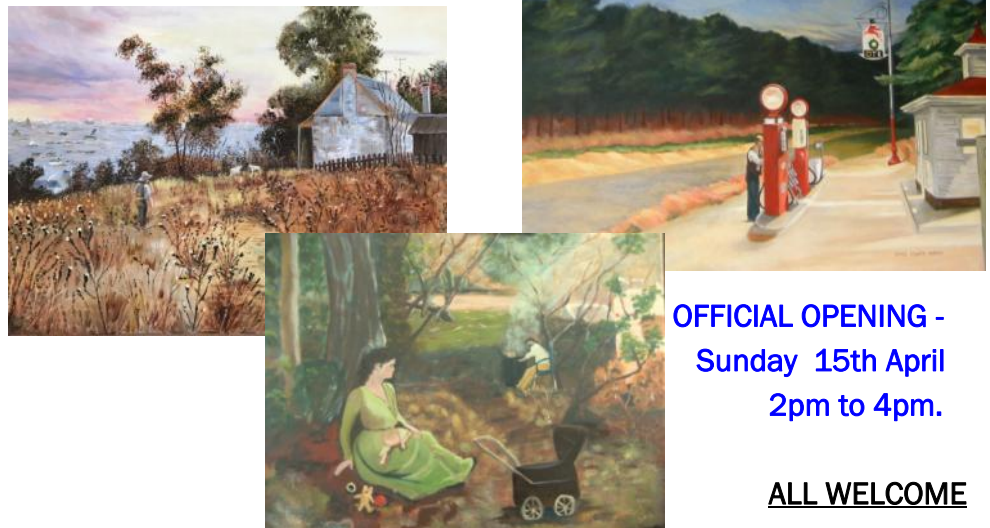

**At the beginning of June we will be opening "PENGUIN BLOOM" in half the gallery.** This is a special photographic exhibition featuring a magpie named Penguin, that helped the Bloom family overcome some of the grief and loss incurred following a devastating accident. Some will have seen and read the book; a movie is in production; so this is your opportunity to see firsthand the exhibition of photographs from the book.

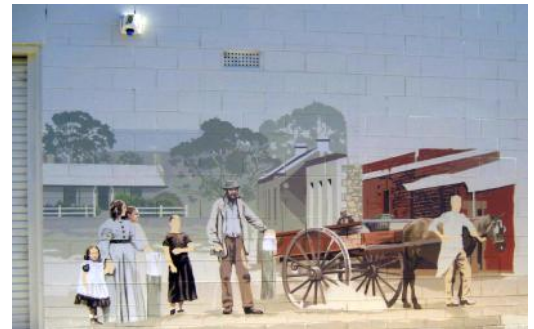
## KAPUNDA MURAL TOWN Update

The next 'Open' exhibiting opportunity at KCG is 'MASTERS WITH A MODERN TWIST' - **Please note that works will only be accepted that meet the stated requirement, including those of 'hanging apparatus' so please check.** If in any doubt—ASK VIA EMAIL.

**Normal Entry Fees and Conditions apply for this exhibition.**

Entries close: 29 March. Delivery: 10 April. Official Opening: 2pm April 15.

**\*\*Entry Forms are available from the Gallery or can be downloaded from the website.**

Paintings and drawings are acceptable. These should substantially be a copy of a 'recognised' artist's work, but with your own addition of something 'modern' that alters the original.

DO NOT sign your name on the front of the work. On the front should be "After ....." (the name of the original artist). Your name should appear on the BACK of the work. Details of the original piece may also be included on the back. **WORKS ARE FOR SALE** as per entry conditions.

ALL ENTRIES must be accompanied by a good quality photograph or photocopy of the ORIGINAL painting/drawing (A5 or A4 size) so that the Viewer can identify the painting and see the modern additions.
