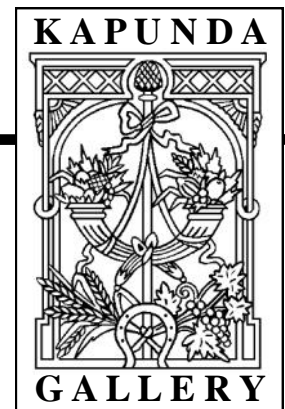

KCG's sincere thanks to the **KAPUNDA LIONS CLUB** who are donating their time to assist us with our 'move' - what a great town we live in!

Whilst we can't give a specific moving date yet for the Gallery to officially transfer from the Thomson Building to the new venue in the Hambour Building, **it is possible that our 25th ANNIVERSARY EXHIBITION,"CELEBRATING KAPUNDA, WHERE WE LIVE"** may well be the **final display in the Thomson Building.**

The Committee are hoping to see a large crowd of Artists, Friends and visitors at the opening of this exhibition which will celebrate 25 years of KCG. Remembering back to the 20th Anniversary Exhibition I am left wondering where the past five years went!

During last week I had the opportunity to look back through some of our 'archived' records as we began sorting and packing for the move. Thanks to some diligent past Committee members and Friends much of KCG's history, celebration and achievement records are still intact. **Copies of The 20 year History booklet edited by John McCarthy and DVD's of the initial Opening and the 20 year Anniversary Opening are available in the Gallery. These make interesting reading and viewing!**

So please join us this Sunday, May 25th for the Opening of "Celebrating Kapunda" by local identity Anne Hornsey and the presentation of Awards, as judged by acclaimed Artist Gerhard Ritter.

We are also going to take the opportunity to say 'Farewell and Thanks' to some very long-standing volunteers who are (or have) retired from 'sitting' in the Gallery.

In the previous 'Hanging Around' I put out a **plea for 'physical and/or financial assistance'**. **A number of Friends have gone out of their way to contribute either or both ,time and money, for which we are extremely grateful.** Monetary donations are being assigned to the purpose directed by the donor where a preference has been stated. Approximately \$700 has been received to date.

One item that is significantly more expensive than anticipated is the Lighting system. **Research has shown that LED LIGHTING is FAR cheaper to run than the existing Halogen system but it is EXPENSIVE to install.** Several Regional galleries are in the process of making the change to LED and it is the ideal opportunity for KCG to install such a system.

Anyone who is still considering a donation may wish to nominate the LED lighting system as a preference. This item will definitely go 'over budget' and we may have to do the system in two stages, as we can afford the work to be done.

The **Sitters afternoon tea was most enjoyable** and a number of our Volunteers met each other for the first time. **What a great bunch of people** who, by the way we will be referring to as 'Gallery Attendants' from now on as this seems to better describe their role in KCG.

HANGING DEVICES AND ARRANGEMENTS

Works should be **suitably framed**. If on **unframed canvas the edges should be finished neatly**.

Glass should be **clean**. Check for marks on the inside of the glass.

All hanging works must be fitted with **large D rings**. **Minimum size is as illustrated below left**. This enables the hanging hook to fit easily into the D ring.

Any artwork that does not have the right D rings **will not be hung**.

(This has been an ongoing problem for the hanging team as incorrect D rings makes correct hanging very difficult.)

The D rings should be **placed from a quarter to one-third down** from the top of the frame with a **taut (not tight) wire** between—centre illustration below

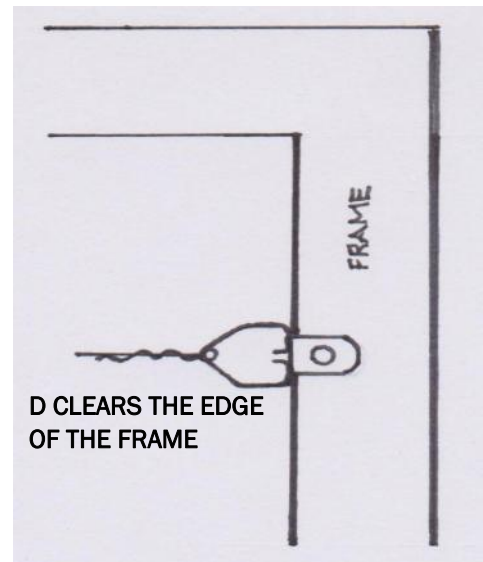
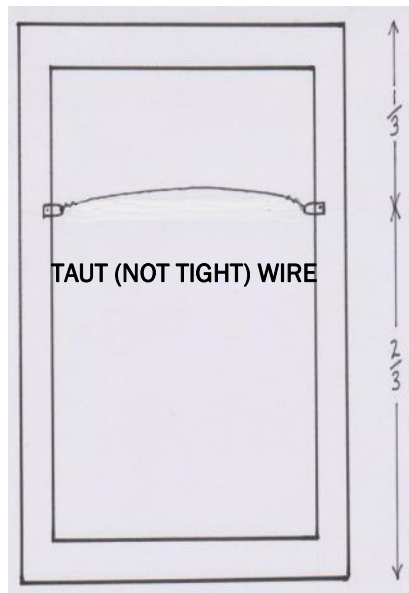
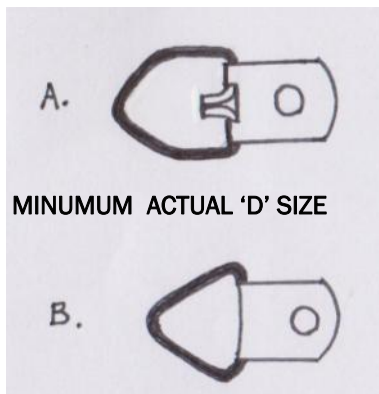
We do not hang by wire. Please do not use cord.

D rings must be placed so that they **clear the inside edge of the frame** (so that the hanging hook has easy access) **as illustrated below right**.

PLEASE SHARE THIS INFORMATION WITH YOUR PICTURE FRAMER.

D rings are for sale in Kapunda Community Gallery.

All works must have a **LABEL** firmly attached to bottom rear corner of work showing **TITLE, ARTIST's NAME, MEDIUM & PRICE**. 3D items should have the label underneath.



DELIVERY AND COLLECTION AT K.C.G.

Artworks are always **DELIVERED** on a given **TUESDAY**, to the Gallery **between 10am and 4pm**. Late works will not be hung.

COLLECTION is always on a given **MONDAY** between **10am and 4pm**.

Please contact the Exhibition Coordinator if genuine difficulties are encountered,

BY THE FRIDAY PRIOR TO THE DELIVERY / COLLECTION DATE.

PLEASE REMEMBER THAT KCG is a TOTALLY VOLUNTARY GALLERY so adherence to all policies is very much appreciated by all our unpaid workers!

EXHIBITING IN THE NORTH KAPUNDA HOTEL DINING ROOM

Hanging devices are the same as for KCG. Changeover of paintings is always the **2nd TUESDAY** of March, June, Sept, Dec. **AT 9 am sharp**. All works **MUST** be collected at that time as there is **no storage facility at the Hotel**.

ALL EXHIBITING ARTISTS ARE REQUIRED TO ASSIST WITH HANGING AT LEAST ONCE PER YEAR—March being the beginning of the hanging year.
