## FROM THE CHAIRPERSON

### Kapunda Community Gallery Inc.

At the May Committee Meeting members discussed the quotes received for renovation work to be done on the 'wet area', an existing small room behind the actual gallery/shop area of our wonderful space. Our plan is to convert this room to a tea-room for use by Gallery Attendants while on duty and for washing up after Exhibition Openings. In brief, the renovation entails stabilizing and lining the walls and floor, creating a door to outside (to toilet) where a window currently exists, connection of water and drainage, installation of a small instant hot water service and electrical points and lighting. In line with our community "Totally Locally" philosophy the work is to be done by tradespeople within the Light Regional Council area.

The quotes total nearly \$11,000 so now KCG is on a mission to make it all happen.

As I write the Gallery is on the eve of preparations for our first 'official' fundraiser for this renovation. Many people have donated art-related goods, paintings and prints for sale; others have loaned paintings of value for which the Gallery will receive a commission if the work sells. I encourage KCG Friends to publicise the sale amongst arty-crafty friends and come along to support this venture. (See page 1 for sale dates.)

Recently the Northern Volunteers Group acknowledged several Volunteers at a special luncheon at the Hewitt Centre. These volunteers were selected from a larger number nominated by various organizations in the northern area and included AUDREY RATSCH, who was suggested and nominated by KCG Friend Jenny Bastians on behalf of the Gallery.

Audrey has been an extremely responsible volunteer at KCG for several years, taking on additional tasks over and above those of Gallery Attendant, which is her principal role. Audrey is a much-valued member of the Exhibition Hanging Team and has recently agreed to oversee the fresh floral decorations in the Gallery.

Thank you Audrey for your dedication and enthusiasm!

The KCG mid-year Open Exhibition with the theme "New Beginnings" will open on Sunday June 7th at 2pm. LRC Mayor Bill O'Brien will officiate. With over 50 exhibits we are looking forward to an interesting display of works. Awards will be presented at the Opening.

### *From Travels in Yorke Peninsula - By John Rees*

Gwenda and I recently spent 2 pleasant weeks exploring around Yorke Peninsula, mainly around the coast because that is where there is the greatest interest in ‘the Yorkes’. However there were two delightful places in the centre of the Peninsula that caught our attention. The first of those was the Maitland Markets. These consist of art and crafts for sale in small old style ‘shops’ that lined the interior of a large, former mechanics workshop and each selling a different art or craft, all of very high quality. The whole was overseen by local artists Robert (Bob) Landt, Fellow and Vice President of the Board of the Royal SA Society of Arts and his wife Jen. At the time we were there Bob was conducting an art class, I suspect of recent beginners. I believe that the former mechanic of the shed was Bob himself who also had one of the mini shops for his own works.

The other event was our visit to the Minlaton Information Centre, called Harvest Corner. Behind the very well set out front information display, were a couple of rooms for an Art Gallery. The display there included several beautiful works, both original and high quality prints by the gifted South Australian artist Allyson Parsons.

Two very fine art surprises on our holiday schedule.
