FROM THE EDITOR / CHAIRPERSON

Kapunda Community Gallery Inc.

Upstairs in the Thomson Building adjacent to the Gallery, the new library office and a library storage cupboard have now been completed. Also a door has been hung to effectively block off the kitchen area.

This has meant a lot of reduction in hanging space resulting in **CHANGED CONDITIONS OF ENTRY and ENTRY FEES** for FUTURE OPEN EXHIBITIONS. **A reduction in the maximum number of entries per person and a slight increase in the entry fees are the major changes.** The changes take effect for the forthcoming Open exhibition "Celebrating South Australia" and all subsequent Open exhibitions.

Another venue for displaying work locally is in the Art Section at the Annual Kapunda Agricultural Show, this year to be held on November 2nd. Sadly the Art entries have declined over past years and the Convenor Jan Harman has put out a timely reminder that this is another venue where your work can be seen and appreciated. [I recently attended the Mt. Pleasant Show and was very impressed with the quantity and quality of Art on display there.] Full details will be in the Show Book, to be published sometime in June and available at shops in and around Kapunda.

In July the Committee are planning on giving the Gallery table, shelves and plinths a fresh coat of paint. **HELP from Friends is MOST WELCOME!**

From all the media reports I have read the 'TURNER FROM THE TATE' Exhibition appears to have been a resounding success for the Art Gallery of SA. It seems that another 'big' exhibition is soon to be announced for 2014. Given the success of the two trips organized by KCG (totalling 55 people) for the Turner exhibition, other such visits seem to warrant the effort.

Whilst there are many exhibitions and venues always on offer, I find The Waterhouse Natural History Art Prize exhibition (at the SA Museum later in the year) is always extremely interesting and does not 'break the bank'!

In addition to AGSA also in the vicinity on North Tce is the Flinders University City Gallery (in the Library complex) and the Royal Society of South Australian Artists Gallery—plenty to see in an 'art day out' and that is without the other outstanding venues west end of the city such as the Jam Factory, Contemporary Art Space and Samstag!

Please put Sunday June 23 in your diary for the next KCG Opening. "Opened Minds" is an exhibition curated by Jenny Bastians and Stuart Hoerisch. It promises to be a great 'mix' of contemporary and the more traditional styles and media and includes 2D and 3D works. Maz McGann, Community and Culture Manager with the Barossa Council (and current Chairperson of the Regional Galleries Association of SA) will open the exhibition.

FINALLY a reminder to KCG artists to prepare pieces for the 'Celebrating South Australia' at KCG in July and the Kapunda Kidman Rotary Art Show in October.

HANGING DEVICES AND ARRANGEMENTS FOR KAPUNDA COMMUNITY GALLERY

Because of the Gallery's somewhat 'archaic' hanging system (picture rail, shark line, screw hooks) **all hanging works MUST be fitted with flat 'D' rings and a TAUT wire.** (NOT CORD)

The D rings should be fitted a suitable distance from the top of the work so that the work hangs fairly flat and does NOT tip forward when hung. **D rings must be of a suitable size to bear the weight of the picture and allow the hanging hook to pass through.** Tiny D rings are unsuitable. Works should be suitably framed, or in the case of unframed works have the edges painted/finished neatly.

All works must have an **information label firmly attached** to the back bottom corner with the Title, Artist's name, media and price clearly written. 3D items should have the label underneath. **“D” RINGS FOR SALE IN THE GALLERY**

DELIVERY AND COLLECTION AT K.C.G.

ARTWORKS ARE **ALWAYS DELIVERED** ON A GIVEN **TUESDAY**, TO THE GALLERY BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 10 and 4.

Delivery dates are given in the Newsletters.

Alternative arrangements for EARLY delivery can be made with the Exhibition Coordinator but **MUST** be

made at least 2 days **PRIOR** to due date of delivery.

WORKS NOT AT THE GALLERY BY 4pm TUESDAY CAN NOT BE HUNG because much time and attention is given to hanging and reshuffling is for late work is not possible. Artworks are **ALWAYS** collected on

a given **Monday**, as notified in the Newsletter.

Contact the Exhibition Coordinator if this is not possible **PRIOR** to the collection date.

(Storage is difficult so try to get someone else to collect your work if you can't.)

COPYRIGHT

This is a HUGE issue! The **SAFEST** way is to paint from your own vision or photographs.

IF YOU USE SOMEONE ELSE'S IDEA, PHOTO, PAINTING, ETC WITHOUT THEIR PERMISSION AND IT IS IN ANY WAY RECOGNISABLE, THEN YOU ARE BREACHING THE COPYRIGHT REGULATIONS.

Unless the image is stated as free of copyright **OR** you have the permission of the holder of the copyright, then you are not legally entitled to use that image.

As a Gallery, KCG is responsible for the promotion of proper copyright ethics.

It is a very complicated area with many 'urban myths' apparent.

COPYRIGHT is an ETHICAL, as well as a LEGAL issue.

When an entry form is signed, and where the conditions state that the work is **ORIGINAL**, it means that the work is **uncopied** and is the **artist's own idea**. This includes an artwork being done from a photographic image—the copyright belongs to the photographer.

Artists are expected at the Hotel at that time to collect previous work/bring new work.

PLEASE CONTACT MAXINE (85663096) IF YOU WISH TO HANG

FOR THE FIRST TIME (for paperwork). New paperwork is only required for **FIRST** timers.

HANGING APPARATUS is exactly the same as for the Gallery.

Again there are time constraints on hanging and late work can not be accepted. (Work can be

delivered or picked up by an agent if you cannot do so personally.)

EXHIBITING ARTISTS ARE REQUIRED TO ASSIST WITH HANGING AT LEAST ONCE PER CALENDAR YEAR.....
