## FROM THE CHAIRPERSON

### Kapunda Community Gallery Inc.

**To say that ‘we’ are all devastated by the current state of the Gallery is an understatement.** So much gained in such a short time to be rendered inoperable in a few very wet minutes .....

Members and Committee were amazing, limiting the losses to a minimum and ensuring safety became the first concern. Our thanks to the MFS for their quick response and to Jenny Maher (for landlord Mark Hambour) who was on hand in a flash with appropriate knowledge and understanding of insurance etc. It was a relief to have Jenny present.

**More important now is “where to next?”**

The building insurance (primarily ceiling damage) has required insurance assessment and quotes for repairs. Naturally a full electrical safety check is required and will be done. These formalities are being undertaken at the time of writing. We are assured that the checks and repairs will be done as speedily as permitted, with everyone involved keen to get the Gallery back on track in the shortest time possible. I personally have faith this will be so.

**The immediate concern is the forthcoming annual “Summer Exhibition”.** This exhibition has been the cornerstone of Members’ exhibitions since the Gallery’s inception 26 years ago. We have a plan—see Page 4.

At the **Nov. 24th Light Regional Council Meeting** the Committee, in conjunction with Kirstie Jamieson from Regional Galleries SA, KCG will be making a presentation updating KCG’s status, activities and plans following our first fifteen months of operation in Main Street. We have LRC to thank for our move and the subsequent expansion we have made—we have recently had a ‘hiccup’ but that need not determine the future!

**Disappointingly**, since my plea in the previous Newsletter NO-ONE has come forward with additional offers of help either to join the Committee, or assist from the sidelines from the AGM in February 2016. I can only hope you have ‘forgotten’ .... and are about to rectify that. **You do not need to be an “Artist” to enjoy the rewards of being involved in a vibrant, innovative community group!**

Speaking of being innovative and vibrant, I have put in a submission for the **“FUND MY IDEA” (Country Cabinet) community initiative**. IF we get on the short list I will be seeking your support to vote online for the ‘idea’ - KAPUNDA, MURAL TOWN! Kapunda has a lot of vacant walls crying out for colourful murals depicting its history and aspirations—Google “Sheffield” in Tasmania to get the idea. We already have two murals. It is a project that can easily involve the WHOLE community in planning, doing and responding to the additional tourism opportunities it would encourage. We have to be ‘in it to win it’ and we are in it!

In a world and time where there is a lot of sorrow and fear I personally prefer to **remain optimistic** and to look to the future .....

I will continue to keep you updated on all matters and there are currently plenty!
