

There are at least two Workshops already planned for next year, both of which we are sure will appeal to a lot of our members. The first is a Drawing & Watercolour workshop with Denis Noble. With THREE Open Exhibitions planned for 2018 we hope that artist Friends will be eager to participate! (Copies of the 2018 Exhibition Calendar are available in the Gallery information spinner and on the KCG website.)

The first of these during April/May is "Masters with a Modern Twist". Works should be based on a painting by a recognised/published Artist, which will largely be copied, but with something 'modern' added as the 'twist' to the original.

A photocopy of the original painting must be presented with the 'new' painting so that viewers can see and appreciate the changes made. An example, already done by many, might be the Mona Lisa holding a mobile phone. Paintings should be signed "After" (the original artist) on the front, not the 'new' artist. Details of the 'new' artist and the original painting name should appear on the back.
