FROM THE CHAIRPERSON — MAXINE DONALD

KCG Committee is charged with serving the interests of KCG and its Members. We take that responsibility very seriously, making decisions with consideration and investigating options to the best of our ability. Some decisions are small, some a little larger, but our most recent has been BIG!

Electricity to run the Gallery 6 hours per day for 7 days per week is a BIG outlay, especially mid summer and mid winter. Currently averaging around \$1000 per quarter and forecast to rise by a further 3% minimum over the next year we have been investigating the solar option for some time, trying to find a suitable deal that could be financially managed without compromising the core mission of the Gallery. **This week we signed a contract to install solar.** The system should be on the roof by the end of November. We will still need to be very vigilant in our use of electricity but we have now taken the necessary steps to minimise the financial impact into the future.

Work on installing a trough and instant Hot Water Service in the rear lobby of the gallery (included in the original Staff room development plan) is almost complete. This will be a great asset for 'mural painters' working in the gallery basement.

I continue to marvel at the amount of hours contributed by all our KCG volunteers. Whilst we recognise the contribution it makes in the first instance to the Gallery, it is in actual fact a HUGE contribution to the health, welfare and economic viability of our entire community.



Sadly the Arts Budget has been slashed both at the Federal and State levels. **We need to continue to recognise and extol the virtues of art as a vital element of our social and economic fabric.** Take a moment to look around—everything starts with a drawing/design, be it housing, transport, town planning, packaging, etc. down to the smallest items. Art IS all around us in some form or another, yet is often so devalued and under-funded.

With only a couple of months until Christmas and hence the winding down of the KCG's year I am imploring members to consider **joining the Management Committee next February, our 30th year.** There are ongoing plans to fulfil and new ventures to chart, all of which require input and expertise from dedicated team workers. **PLEASE think about it!**

If anyone has any requests or ideas for **Art Workshops or Demonstrations for 2019** we would love to hear them.

Visitors to the Gallery continue to average over 400 per month. Comments from our visitors are very positive, regarding the quality of the art and artisan works on display and on the friendly, helpful gallery staff.

Following the receipt of \$600 from the Light Regional Council Community Grants scheme recently, the KMT team has subsequently been advised by the South Australian History Trust that our grant application for \$3000 towards the proposed Farming and Agricultural mural on the Clare Castle Hotel was **SUCCESSFUL!** Thank you to HTSA for this invaluable financial assistance and to Jim Dustan for his exciting concept! Another blank wall to be adorned!

Some months ago **KCG and RSL member Tony Hersey** applied for a grant for a **mural** on the southern wall of the Prince of Wales hotel cool room, **commemorating the arenas of conflict and sacrifice by our servicemen and service women in the past 100 years.** Tony has previously painted murals for the RSL in Renmark and we are delighted that his application has been successful now in Kapunda.
