September was a memorable month— the Official Opening in the new premises; THE most financially successful sales period in the history of KCG; the Opening of “Printmakers” Exhibition and the collation of statistics showing the reasons put forward by the Committee to relocate KCG are indeed proving correct. ATTENDANCE at the Gallery doubled in the first month: gift shop and exhibition SALES were substantially higher; FRIENDS MEMBERSHIP rose..... NOW TO KEEP THE MOMENTUM GOING!

The **BIG SIGN** on the southern wall (**GENEROUSLY DONATED**) was in place for the Opening, thanks to the efficient work of Tony from Dynamix Signs in Gawler. We are currently waiting on Council approval to erect a second sign on the northern end of the verandah—hopefully soon!

Having talked in my speech at the Opening, of the **need for running water in the building**, (which we currently don't have), true to his word the **Member for Stuart, Dan** delivered the first of the necessary items just a week later the sink!

The Committee is now thinking carefully about what is practical, necessary and financially viable in the renovation of the proposed wet area. **We need to get the basics right.**

It is “that time of year” again when we look **toward next year 2015**, the exhibition calendar, the composition of the Committee and the events and activities that will ensure KCG continues the current momentum.

The AGM will be held in February and ALL COMMITTEE POSITIONS WILL BE UP FOR GRABS. I urge you all to consider nominating to be part of the team that continues the momentum gained thus far. **THERE WILL BE VACANCIES!** The Committee NEEDS AND APPRECIATES ‘new blood’ and new ideas! (Talk to me!)

KCG has registered to take part in the annual KAPUNDA GARAGE SALE DAY on NOVEMBER 8th (opening the gates on to Brown Street directly behind the Gallery). If you have any **SMALL SALEABLE ITEMS** they may be left in the back ground floor lobby area of the building, between 10am and 4pm, up to Nov. 6th. No heavy or unsaleable items please! Help on the day would also be appreciated—leave your name at the Gallery desk. (This is the first of some planned fund-raising ventures to ‘build around the sink’!!)

HANGING DEVICES AND ARRANGEMENTS

Works should be **suitably framed**. If on **unframed canvas** the edges should be finished neatly.

Glass should be **clean**. Check for marks on the **inside of the glass**.

All hanging works must be fitted with **large D rings**. **Minimum size is as illustrated below left**. This enables the hanging hook to fit easily into the D ring.

Any artwork that does not have the CORRECT ‘D’ rings will not be hung.

(This has been an ongoing problem for the hanging team as incorrect D rings makes correct hanging very difficult.)

The D rings should be **placed from a quarter to one-third down** from the top of the frame with a **taut (not tight) wire** between—**centre illustration below**

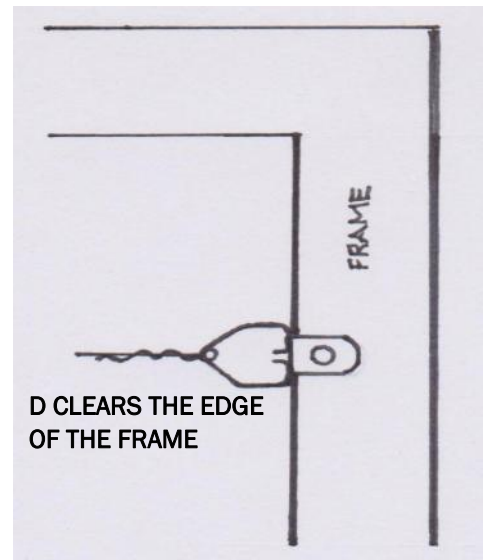
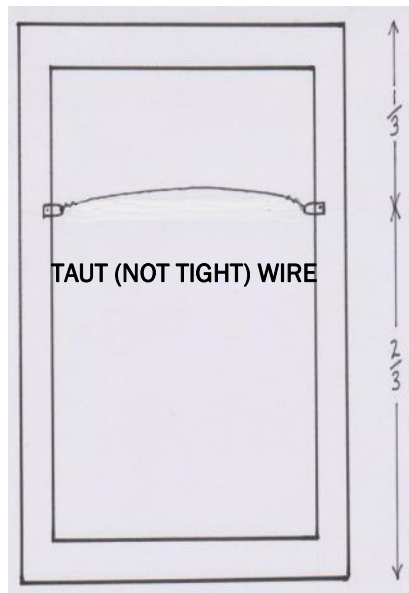
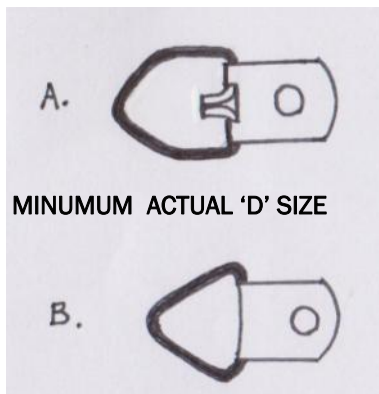
We do not hang by wire. **Please do not use cord.**

D rings must be placed so that they **clear the inside edge of the frame** (so that the hanging hook has easy access) **as illustrated below right.**

PLEASE SHARE THIS INFORMATION WITH YOUR PICTURE FRAMER.

D rings are for sale in Kapunda Community Gallery.

All works must have a **LABEL** firmly attached to **bottom rear corner of work** showing **TITLE, ARTIST’S NAME, MEDIUM & PRICE**. 3D items should have the label underneath.



DELIVERY AND COLLECTION

DELIVERY is ALWAYS on a GIVEN TUESDAY. The **DATE** for each Exhibition is listed on the **KCG Exhibition Calendar** and **OPEN Exhibition delivery dates** are given in Newsletter (Hanging Around) when the exhibition is advertised. **DELIVERY HOURS are strictly between 10am and 4pm on the advertised TUESDAY.**

COLLECTION is ALWAYS on a GIVEN MONDAY and is also listed on the Exhibition Calendar. **COLLECTION is strictly between the hours of 10am and 4pm on the given MONDAY.**

EXHIBITORS ARE REQUESTED TO ADHERE TO THESE ARRANGEMENTS AS EVERYONE AT KCG IS A VOLUNTEER. If there are genuine difficulties with Delivery or Collection please contact the Exhibition Coordinator, Jenny Bastians to make alternative arrangements (see Committee contact details, P 2.)
