FROM THE CHAIRPERSON — MAXINE DONALD

If anyone can **volunteer to assist on Garage Sale Day (Nov. 4th) for an hour or so at the Gallery** we would be most grateful. "Many hands make light work" is true and our Convenors Jenny and Marg would appreciate some assistance. Please email or leave your name at the Gallery desk. (Contributions to the sale can be left at the Gallery from Oct. 31st.

As I read through these monthly reports I realize that my words are frequently devoted to ASKING FOR HELP to do things, or raise money for a project at hand. To me this comes about for a couple of different reasons. The first is very **positive**—we are a progressive gallery with goals to improve not only our own gallery environment, but that of the wider arts and cultural community. The second is rather **negative**—that less and less external funding money is accessible to assist community groups to survive, let alone thrive.

In order to thrive we must embrace change and for an organization to do that we need to be open to new ideas and ways of working. One of our biggest challenges is to recruit dedicated, forward-thinking members to the core management of KCG. That is becoming extremely difficult in our fast-paced, time-poor, 'here and now' society.

Sound financial and structural management is paramount to KCG and we appear to have reached the point where in order to maintain that we are going to have to **PAY** for that expertise, either by employing someone for a few hours a week, or paying for tasks to be done which have previously been done gratis. In order to pay someone we need to fund the added expense—

Are our member Friends willing to pay increased fees to meet the additional expense? That appears to be the bottom line and the one with which your committee is currently grappling. KCG fees in all areas are low (by comparison to other comparable organizations) and we have deliberately tried to maintain that BUT it is no longer viable if we are to maintain the standard to which we are accustomed, aspire and are legally bound to adhere to (by the Associations Act).

This conversation **MUST** be had and it must be **NOW** as any such changes need to come into practise at the next AGM in February 2018. It is a dilemma we must face— and **your committee REQUIRES** your input **to make the hard decisions.**

Please sit down for a few minutes and put pen to paper; fingers to keyboard; or however you wish to do it. Just let me know what **YOU** think may be a viable solution. (Email and Postal addresses on the front of the Newsletter, or drop a note into the Gallery.)
