HANGING DEVICES AND ARRANGEMENTS FOR KAPUNDA COMMUNITY GALLERY

Because of the Gallery's somewhat 'archaic' hanging system (picture rail, shark line, screw hooks) all hanging works MUST be fitted with flat 'D' rings and a TAUT wire. (NOT CORD)

The D rings should be fitted a suitable distance from the top of the work so that the work hangs fairly flat and does NOT tip forward when hung. D rings must be of a suitable size to bear the weight of the picture and allow the hook through.

Works should be suitably framed, or in the case of unframed works have the edges painted/finished neatly.

All works must have an information label firmly attached to the back bottom corner with the Title, Artist's name, media and price clearly written. 3D items should have the label underneath. Η

Time and attention is given to hanging and reshuffling is not possible. Artworks are ALWAYS collected on a given Monday, as notified in the Newsletter.

Contact the Exhibition Coordinator if this is not possible PRIOR to collection date.

(Storage facility may soon not be available so try to get someone else to collect yours if necessary.)

HANGING APPARATUS is **exactly** the same as for the Gallery.

Again there are time constraints on hanging

and late work can not be accepted. (Work can be delivered/collected by a relative or friend as long as we know prior.)
