I chose the venue to be a 'safe' one—in a Gallery with
which I am associated, in a community setting where I
am known to some extent.

It is an excellent Gallery space as well as having all
the amenities for support such as good opening
hours, gallery attendants, hanging assistance and
well-established general procedures. Hire and Com-
mission charges are extremely reasonable and there
are no 'hidden extras' or 'fine print'!

Whilst many of the 85 who attended the Opening
were local, possibly half were from elsewhere and a
trip to Kapunda (luckily on a perfect day) was an
“outing” that they seemed to relish! I sent out LOTS
of invitations.

I chose Prof. Goldney to open the Exhibition, knowing
that he would 'enjoy' the opportunity to do so and that
he would also mingle, have a message for those at-
tending and thus 'enhance' the Opening.

The morals of the story are, how lucky Kapunda art-
ists are to have the facility and don't be afraid to use
