**“WORKS ON PAPER” ....K.C.G.’s latest OPENING**

**Robert Laidlaw, Bunyip Newspaper’s Arts Page Editor, Senior Sports Journalist, keen photographer, Central Districts Football Club’s Historian, Baseball S.A’s Historian, Chair of Gawler’s Road Safety Group, keen photographer and who also has an interest in theatre and music, opened K.C.G.’s latest exhibition on Sunday 17 March.**

Robert has supported the Gallery through publication of our exhibitions and events over the past decade and it was a privilege to hear him speak about how, through his role as Arts Page Editor for the Bunyip, he has become much more involved and interested in the visual arts. Taking on the role, in addition to his much-loved sports editor position came almost by default, but it is obvious that Robert has embraced the visual arts and now feels quite at ease in the local visual arts circle.

About 40 people enjoyed Robert’s Opening, which included his reaction to several of the paintings on display—these included Jen Searle’s “Those Eyes” (Number 1 in the catalogue) which Rob commented made such a fitting introduction to leading the audience into the rest of the very interesting and diverse exhibition.

It was good to hear Rob’s journey from a ‘walk-in, walk-out’ spectator at visual art exhibitions to becoming a ‘lingering visual participant’, interested in the art and with an appreciation for the skilful creation of works.

There are 48 works on display in various media, including dry point and other printing techniques, pastel, pencil, charcoal, watercolour, gouache, mixed media and photographs—something to appeal to everyone!

# HANGING DEVICES AND ARRANGEMENTS FOR KAPUNDA COMMUNITY GALLERY

Because of the Gallery’s somewhat ‘archaic’ hanging system (picture rail, shark line, screw hooks) all hanging works MUST be fitted with flat ‘D’ rings and a TAUT wire. (NOT CORD)

The D rings should be fitted a suitable distance from the top of the work so that the work hangs fairly flat and does NOT tip forward when hung. D rings must be of a suitable size to bear the weight of the picture and allow the hook through.

Works should be suitably framed, or in the case of unframed works have the edges painted/finished neatly.

All works must have an information label firmly attached to the back bottom corner with the Title, Artist’s name, media and price clearly written. 3D items should have the label underneath.

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## DELIVERY AND COLLECTION AT K.C.G.

ARTWORKS ARE ALWAYS DELIVERED ON A GIVEN TUESDAY, TO THE GALLERY BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 10 and 4.

Delivery dates are given in the Newsletters.

Alternative arrangements for EARLY delivery can be made with the Ex. Coordi-

nator (85663159) but MUST be made at least 2 days PRIOR to due date of delivery.

**WORKS NOT AT THE GALLERY BY 4pm TUESDAY CAN NOT BE HUNG.**

Time and attention is given to hanging and re-shuffling is not possible.

Artworks are ALWAYS collected on a given Monday, as notified in the Newsletter.

Contact Ex. Coordinator if this is not possible PRIOR to collection date.

(Storage facility may soon not be available so try to get someone else to collect yours if necessary.)
