The EIGHTH biennial Art Show will be held from **Friday 29 October to Wednesday 3 November 2021** in the Soldiers Memorial Hall Kapunda and in conjunction with the **Kapunda Community Gallery Inc.**

Artists are invited to participate in the following categories:

**Watercolour and/or Gouache \$1,000**

**Drawing and/or Pastels \$1,000**

**Photography \$1,000**

**Sculpture and 3 Dimensional Works \$1,000**

**Connection to the Land**  
*(Special prize donated by JT Johnsons and open to all entrants)*

**People's Choice \$250**



## The Rotary Club of Kapunda Inc. 2021 Art Show Conditions of Entry

- 1. Eligibility.** The Art Show is open to all artists.
- 2. Judge or Judges** of the Show shall be a person or persons selected by the organisers and will inspect all entries. If the Judge(s) do(es) not award a prize in any category the prize monies shall be carried forward to the next Show held by The Rotary Club of Kapunda Inc. The decisions of the Judge(s) are final.
- 3. Number of Entries.** Each artist may enter a maximum of three (3) exhibits at **either** venue i.e. If entering 3 works in Institute categories, additional entries may be entered in the Photographic section, with the same 3 fee tiers applying. In this instance 2 Entry Forms should be submitted. (A "pair" will be considered as two entries.)
- 4. All works submitted to the Show must be available for sale.** A maximum of 380 entries will be accepted for the 2021 Show.
- 5. Prizes.** No exhibit may be awarded more than one prize, apart from the "People's Choice" prize. An Acquisitive Prize has been donated by the Light Regional Council. The winner of this prize will receive the full amount of prize money. **Please consider the amount of the prize money in comparison to the sale price of the painting when filling out your entry form.** The entry awarded the Acquisitive Prize becomes the property of the Light Regional Council
- 6. Exhibit Requirements.**  
**All** exhibits must:
  - be the original, uncopied work of the artist.
  - be in a permanent media and ENTIRELY dry.
  - have been executed after 30 October 2019.**Drawings, Paintings, Photographs** must:
  - not exceed 1.1m (110cm), including frame, on the longest side. Please check as no exceptions will be made.
  - be presented according to professionally accepted standards (i.e. undamaged frames, LARGE 'D' hooks and wire attached, of sufficient strength to support the weight).

**Sculptures/3D Art** exceeding 60kg in weight and 1 cubic metre in volume require pre-show approval.

**CONNECTION TO THE LAND:** Only works not gaining a first place in any other category (except the People's Choice) will be eligible for the prize. There is no extra fee charged. **Entry in this Category will be at the Judge's discretion for suitability to the theme.**

## 7. Entry Conditions:

7.1 **SECTION A of the Entry Form.** Section A must be completed in full, signed and lodged by each artist with the appropriate non-refundable entry fee. **Entry Fees: \$10 for one, \$18 for two and \$25 for 3 exhibits.**

**The final date for submission of Entry Forms is 5 pm Friday 1st October 2021 WITH NO EXCEPTIONS. Entry to the Show may be closed earlier than 1st October 2021 if the limit of 380 entries is reached before that date.**

All works entered can be considered to be accepted (provided they meet the standards set in "6" of the conditions) unless the Artist is advised otherwise. i.e. if the number of entries exceed 380 no further entries will be accepted. Fees received for any entries the Show is unable to accept will be refunded. All entry forms will be date stamped on receipt.

7.2 **SECTION B of the Entry Form.** Section B must be attached to the back of each entry, with the required details completed **BEFORE** DELIVERY OF ARTWORK.

7.3 **DELIVERY OF EXHIBITS: WED. 27TH OCT. NOON – 6pm.**

**ALL PAINTING, DRAWING, SCULPTURE/3D** -to the Soldiers' Memorial Hall, Hill Street, KAPUNDA.

**PHOTOGRAPHY** – to KAPUNDA COMMUNITY GALLERY Inc. corner Main St and Browns St, Kapunda. (67 Main St)

**LATE DELIVERY EXHIBITS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.** Exhibits must be packaged appropriately. Northern KOPE, Wingfield (8345 1800) run a daily delivery service to Kapunda. **ALL DELIVERY COSTS BORNE BY THE ARTIST.**

Artists are wholly responsible for the appropriate packaging and insuring of their works during transit and for the duration of the Art Show.

7.4 **Collection of Exhibits.** Wednesday 3/11/21 from 3.00 pm to 6.00 pm or Thursday 4/11/21 from 9 am to 11 am. N.B. No works will be released prior to these times.

7.5 **Sale Price. All entries must be for sale** at the price indicated on the Entry Form. **The price of an entry CANNOT be altered once it has been received, for reasons of catalogue compilation.**

7.6 **Commission for Sale.** In the event of a sale, the Rotary Club of Kapunda will charge a commission of twenty five percent (25%) to go towards fundraising for community and international projects. Please check entry forms for GST conditions. Exhibits sold will carry a red sticker. Artists should check with the sales desk to confirm that the sticker has been correctly affixed. No responsibility can be accepted for stickers affixed in error.

7.7 **Rights Reserved.** The Rotary Club of Kapunda reserves the right to reject any entry, to limit the number of exhibits on display (limited to 380 for 2021), and to not award a prize in a particular section if the Judge(s) consider that no work of sufficient merit has been entered.

For the proper and orderly conduct of the Show, The Rotary Club of Kapunda also reserves the right, in its sole discretion, at any time and without prior notice to amend, alter or vary any of the conditions of the entry or to do any other thing which it deems fit.

The Rotary Club of Kapunda reserves the right to publish the artists' names (but not the artists' addresses or other personal information) and a photograph of any entries in the Show Catalogue, artists' newsletter, newspaper, social media and the Rotary Club of Kapunda web site.

7.8 **Responsibility for Loss or Damage.** All reasonable care will be exercised in the handling of submitted works. However, no responsibility will be accepted by the organisers for the loss or damage of any works or packaging while in transit to or from the Show or while in the custody of the organisers or their agents. **The provision of suitable insurance cover is the responsibility of the artist for the transport of exhibits to and from the exhibition and for the duration of the Show.**

7.9 **Duration of Exhibits.** All exhibits on view will remain in the Show whether sold or not, until the collection time from 3.00 pm on Wednesday 3/11/21.
